INVESTMENT APPROACH

The objective of the fund is to seek capital growth by investing in shares of Asian companies which are leaders in terms of technology or innovation. The fund assets are mainly invested in shares having their head office or their main activity in Asia-Pacific, comprising smaller and medium sized (SMID-cap) corporations.

FUND MANAGER'S COMMENTS

Our fund increased by 0.87% in February, and the net asset value (NAV) per share closed at 92.41.

Last month, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) held the repo rate steady at 6.5%, reflecting a nuanced strategic manoeuvre. While maintaining the rate, the RBI's action signals a cautious yet anticipatory approach to fostering economic growth amidst a cooling inflation environment. This stance, juxtaposed with the Bank of Japan's mixed corporate sentiment in the Tankan survey and South Korea's promising export growth led by semiconductors, paints a complex picture of the Asia-Pacific region's economic dynamics. Such moves indicate a broader trend of central banks worldwide navigating the delicate balance between stimulating economic activities and managing inflationary pressures in an uncertain global economic climate. China's ambitious agenda to catalyse growth through innovation and high-tech industries was central to the narrative of economic shifts and strategic foresight. The government's 2024 work report lays a clear emphasis on breaking foreign dependencies on critical technologies, fostering supply chain independence, and nurturing new industries as pivotal to China's economic transformation. With a projected increase in the high-tech sector's contribution to nearly 19% of GDP by 2026, from 14.3% in 2023, the strategic investment in this sector is poised to redefine China's economic trajectory. However, this ambitious growth is not without its hurdles; challenges such as increasing technological decoupling with Western economies, alongside internal factors like market confidence and innovation mechanisms, pose significant risks to this optimistic outlook.

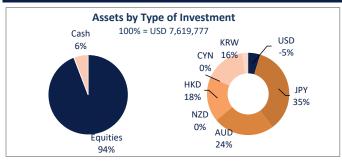
